MASS DIRECTOR'S NOTES

In General

- 1. Observe all dynamic markings.
- 2. Follow composers' directions for special techniques. This includes LV, shake, echo, malleting (both suspended and on the table), martellato, martellato lift, pluck, SB, RT.
- 3. Practice pieces at several tempi so that you can adjust if needed for the sake of staying together.
- 4. Be prepared to watch the director, especially for fermatas and ritards.

How Can I Keep from Singing?

Mass

- 1. Please read the back page of the music for directions to perform the SB. Read all composer notes about stopping the SB.
- 2. To begin the piece, I will cue the SB bells to begin. When I hear them all sounding, I will begin to count mm. 1-4.
- 3. MM 60 as suggested by the composer—no faster!
- 4. At m. 12 the bottom note should be played with chimes.
- 5. The fermatas in mm 42 and 47 will be observed. You will need to watch!
- 6. Meno mosso means less motion, or slower. Again watch!
- 7. M. 49 is repeated. We will repeat m. 59 two times (play the measure three times).

With your excellent preparations, I am sure that these pieces will sound forth glad praises to God.
